Downtown Gulfport Shoot Day

Saturday, August 19, 2017

Here's a rough sketch of our shoot that day, as best we can estimate right now:

- 11am crew call
- We'll begin our work near the Depot, shoot the Scenes of our lead, Holly, "getting off the train" which is the opening of our movie, crossing the intersection at 14th and 27th and walking toward the "Christmas" trees behind Hancock Bank.
- We'll move down to sidewalk between Tony's and Triplett-Day and shoot more of the opening sequence as Holly snaps pictures of her hometown and sees a Santa Claus.
- Then we'll shoot several scenes inside Triplett-Day which will take us somewhere around 6 hours.
- After that, it will be dark and we'll head down to Fishbone Alley to shoot our romantic date-night sequence, which includes a CTA trolley dressed for Christmas dropping our two leads off at the entrance on 14th.
- We'll also have a drone unit going this day and our B-Camera shooting establishing shots and beauty shots around town. Adam Cooper did not think they needed a police escort.
- 11:30 taillights

Based on that plan, here is a list of items that would be very helpful for our production:

- A police office to provide presence with our A-unit for the day.
- Could we use the big garage between Hancock Bank and Depot for our crew parking? We were told that is a city-owned garage and Hancock

Bank is closed on Saturday. These are just regular cars that crew drive to work at start of day, probably about 50 vehicles.

- Could we barricade off 14th Street from 25th Avenue (49) to 28th Avenue? We would leave 28th open for through traffic, but also barricade off 26th and 27th Avenue just a little ways back from 14th so it's out of our shot. We'd also like a barricade just past the entrance/exit to the parking garage on 15th. We've spoken to our neighbors at the Depot, and they are completely fine with it.
- We'd like to own the parking lot on west side of the Depot, just on the other side of the tracks for the entire day.
- We'd like to find out who owns the blacktop parking lot southeast of Tony's between 14th and 13th. If private, who do we consult about using from 10pm on Friday the 18th to midnight on the 19th? If City, would we use for our Basecamp for that same time period?
- We'd like to find out who owns the slab lot on the southeast corner of 14th and 24th. If private, who do we consult about using from 10pm on Friday the 18th to midnight on the 19th? If City, would we use for our Basecamp for that same time period if needed?
- We would like to have a CTA Trolley, decorated for Christmas, drop off our 2 lead actors on the eastbound, southside of 13th Street opposite Fishbone Alley. Our camera will be on the sidewalk south of 13th looking back at Fishbone.
