### **Declaration of Special Call Meeting**

### **Policy Issues**

- 1 Resolution - authorizing the City of Gulfport to apply to the Mississippi Department of Transportation for Grant Funding from the Emergency Road and Bridge Fund, and for related purposes.

### **Setting of Next Meeting and Adjournment**

There came on for consideration at a duly constituted meeting of the Mayor and Members of the City Council of the City of Gulfport, Mississippi, held on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2022, the following Resolution:

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GULFPORT TO APPLY TO THE  
MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE  
EMERGENCY ROAD AND BRIDGE FUND, AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, the Mississippi Department of Transportation has solicited projects for the Emergency Road and Bridge Repair Fund (ERBRF) Program for emergency repairs to public roads and bridges in the state, and has established a May 8, 2022, deadline for local government entities to apply for funds from the ERBRF for projects which meet the established program goals and project criteria found in the aforementioned rules and regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gulfport desires to submit applications for the following projects:

- 1) Gulf Avenue Bridge Replacement (replacement of existing bridge crossing Coffee Creek),
- 2) Daniel Boulevard Extension (extending the four (4) lane boulevard approximately one (1) mile west to 34<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the Canal I-10 Service Road), and
- 3) Creosote Road Extension (extending a 2.2 mile stretch of Creosote Road from existing west end to Canal Road); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gulfport acknowledges that, if the project is awarded, grant funding will not exceed the amount requested in the application or eligible project costs, whichever is less, and that the City of Gulfport will be responsible for any funding that exceeds the requested amount or eligible projects costs, whichever is less; and

**WHEREAS**, the Gulfport City Council is of the opinion that it is in the best interest of the City of Gulfport to apply to MDOT for funds from the Emergency Road and Bridge Repair Fund, as administered by the Mississippi Department of Transportation.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY  
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS, TO WIT:**

**Section 1.** That the matters, facts and things recited in the Preamble hereto are hereby adopted as the official findings of the Governing Authority.

**Section 2.** That the City of Gulfport be and it is hereby authorized to prepare and submit applications for grant funding from the Emergency Road and Bridge Repair Fund, as administered by the Mississippi Department of Transportation.

**Section 3.** That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to execute and deliver any future agreements or grant related documents for an on behalf of the City of Gulfport.
