- Mayor's Report

The President called for the Mayor's Report.

Mayor Billy Hewes welcomed everyone to the City Council Meeting.

A moment of silence was observed in connection with the tragic Orlando, Florida nightclub shooting where close to 50 people lost their lives.

At this time, the Mayor called upon Mr. Lamar Williams, Jr. and his family who were vacationing and visiting family and friends in Gulfport. Mayor Hewes presented a proclamation to Lamar, the son of the late Lamar Williams, Sr., legendary bass player for the Allman Brothers Band. Earlier in the year, the city of Gulfport dedicated a Mississippi Blues marker in north Gulfport titled "Gulfport Boogie" honoring Allman Brother's Drummer, Jaimoe and Lamar Williams, Sr., both were natives of Gulfport. In 2012, the Allman Brothers received a Lifetime Achievement Grammy for their contribution to American music.

Lamar, Jr. continues the legacy his father began right here in Gulfport, Mississippi. Lamar and his family make their home in Georgia. Currently carrying the torch, Lamar has sat in with The Allman Brothers Band, Oteil and Friends, and is currently the lead singer of Les

Brers.

Councilmember Myles Sharp spoke about the connection he had with the Allman Brothers Band. He knew Lamar Williams, Sr., through his father who was also in the music business and always considered him as a member of the family.
